

Presidential Management Fellows (PMF) Program

CLASS OF 2015 SEARCH CRITERIA

The following identifies some of the search criteria agencies can use when searching Finalists in the PMF TAS (Talent Acquisitions System) for the Class of 2015 cycle. There are four lists below on what applicants could choose from when applying to the PMF Program: (1) a list of programs of study\degrees\disciplines (graduate or undergraduate), (2) a list of additional skills and competencies, (3) a list of languages, and (4) a list of preferred geographic employment locations. In addition, agency users can search by class year (when there is potential for overlapping classes), name (first or last name), education level, adjudicated veterans' preference, academic institution, and type of appointment (e.g., Finalist vs. PMF STEM Finalist).
